Kingston to Watermans

From Kingston to Watermans: From Eden Street, Kingston (Stop E3) take 65 Bus towards Ealing Broadway (40 mins, 31 stops). Get off at Watermans Centre (Stop BH) --In front of Watermans!

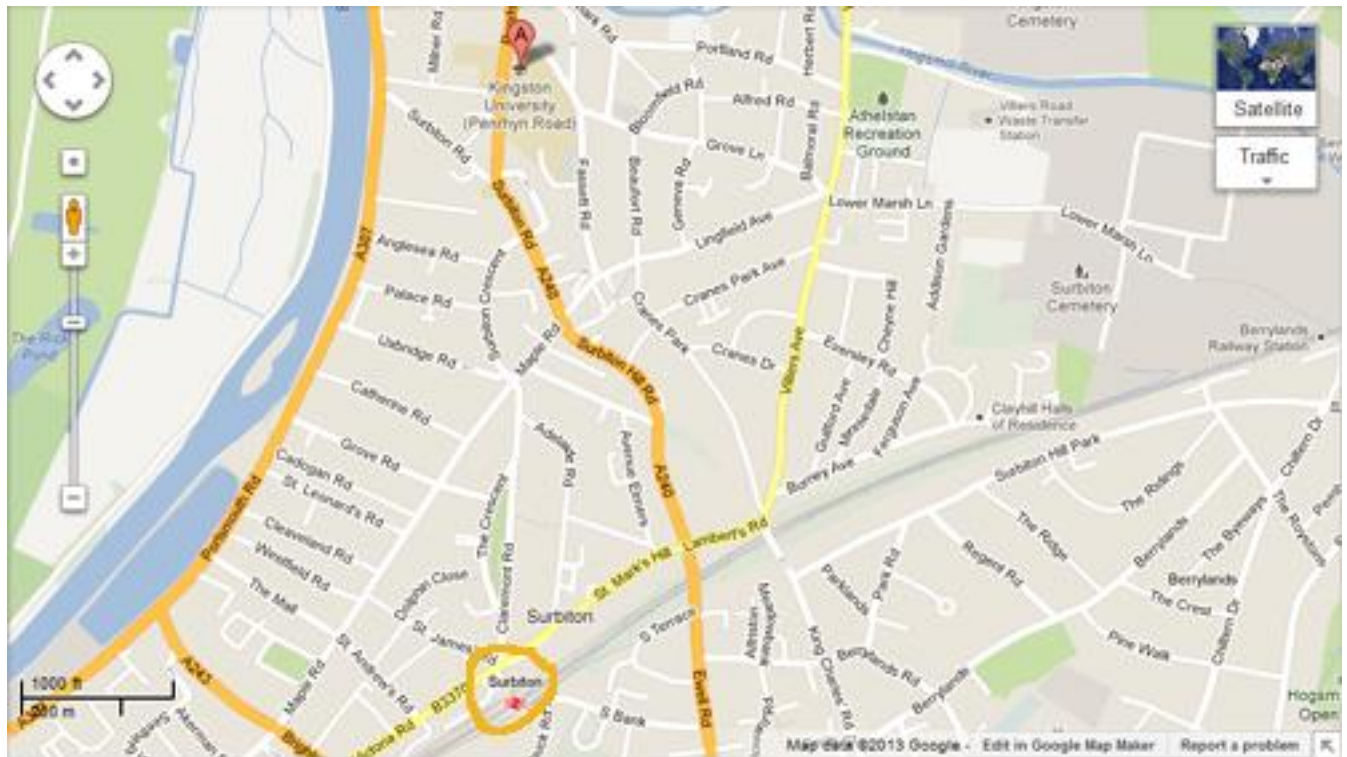
Kingston to London

Take the train from Kingston Railway Station or Surbiton Railway Station (about a 15 minute walk from the university). The Kingston Railway Station is closer but has less frequent trains. The Surbiton Railway Station has more frequent, faster trains. To get to Surbiton from Kingston University Penrhyn Road, walk or take any bus (quick ride 3 or 4 short stops) to Surbiton Railway Station.

(From Surbiton Railway Station to Kingston University, there are direct buses leaving you outside the main entrance at Penrhyn Road. Take Route Bus K2 from Stop NN outside Surbiton Station towards Kingston Hospital, Route Bus 71 from Stop NB towards Kingston, or Route Bus 281 from Stop NN towards Hounslow Bus Station. All stops are just opposite the main entrance to the train station.)

- From Surbiton Railway Station or Kingston Railway Station to the [Poetry Library](#). Take the Train to London Waterloo (27 minutes, 7 stops). From the Waterloo stop, walk to Southbank Centre. About 5 mins (0.2 mi). See "London Venues", Note (1) following.
- From Surbiton Railway Station or Kingston Railway Station to the [Tate Britain](#). Take the Train to Vauxhall (22 minutes, 6 stops). Walk to Tate Britain. About 11 mins (0.5 mi). See "London Venues", Note (2) following.

(1) Poetry Library. Location: 5th floor at the Royal Festival Hall, Southbank Centre, London SE1 8XX. Nearest tube: Waterloo (direct line from Surbiton or Kingston).

(2) Tate Britain. The nearest Tube for the Tate Britain is Pimlico but from Kingston or Surbiton we can go to Vauxhall and walk across the bridge.
